arm level, radial side, there is a scar $\frac{1}{2}$ x $\frac{1}{4}$ inch which is a shrapnel scar. It is asymptomatic. On tapping over the dorsum of hand in region between first and second metacarpal paresthesia is produced which radiates into the thumb. He has a full normal range of motion of rt arm. Over most of the lateral portion of rt pelvis there is scattered pepper tattooing which is asymptomatic. He also states he had scalp wounds on rt, but no scarring is visible and he has no complaints of his head trauma.
