This correspondence is in reference to your July 12, 2023, Board of Veterans' Appeals hearing with Veterans Law Judge Lauren Cryan. It is the decision of the Board to act on its own motion and recuse Judge Cryan from further participation in your appeal.

Your appeal was received at the Board on September 9, 2019. On July 12, 2023, you participated in a Board videoconference hearing, during which you provided testimony to a Veterans Law Judge in Washington, DC. A transcript of this hearing has been made a part of the record, and an audio recording of the hearing has been reviewed. After review, and with agreement from Judge Cryan, the Board finds that recusal of Judge Cryan is warranted. See 38 C.F.R. § 20.107(b); see also 38 U.S.C. §§ 7102, 7104.

Consequently, you have the right to request another Board hearing. Please check **one** of the statements on the attached page, sign and date the form, and then return it to us within **30 days** from the date of this letter. **If you do not respond within 30 days from the date of this letter**, the Board will assume that you do not want another hearing and proceed accordingly. Please remember, a request for a hearing, especially an in-person hearing at a VA Regional Office, can significantly delay the issuance of a decision by the Board. Please also note that the Board cannot pay for your travel to get to a hearing.
